

Bobbs W/end Away – Dad’s responsibilities

Brothers, The Men’s Weekend Away is a highlight of the year. To keep it as a memorable highlight, we want to ensure that you take **responsibility for the safety of your children.**

To come on the Men’s Weekend Away, all fathers must have read this document, and along with your wife, signed off as having understood your responsibilities. Failure to do this will mean you cannot attend the Weekend Away or may be asked to leave the camp.

Basic Rule

At all times on the Men’s Weekend Away, your children are your responsibility. At all times you must know where they are, who they are with and what they are doing. No exceptions, no excuses.

Free Time

I understand that I am responsible for my children during free time. I will instruct my children to let me know of their movements. I will know where my children are at all times. I will not take other children to activities onsite without explicit permission from the child’s father and with less than 2 adults. I will not take other children offsite unless they are accompanied by their father.

Water

If my children are in the water (ocean or lake), I will be their supervisor (I will not be talking on the beach, playing footy on the beach, but in the water watching them!).

Toilets

I will instruct my children of the hazards of toilet blocks. My children will tell me when they go to the toilet block. When my children are at the toilet block I will pay careful attention to their return and safety.

Night Time

I will not let my children wander around the campsite at night time. I will put my children to bed at a suitable time. I will instruct my children on the importance of not getting up and wandering around after they have been put to bed.

Age of Children

My children are school aged and my daughters are in Primary School only.

What not to bring: Alcohol, drugs, or pets.

Food: Will be supplied but please inform the organisers if there are allergies that need to be considered.
